Terms & Conditions:

- (1) Stitching charges should be inclusive of buttons / Hooks / canvas/ Pocketing/ / Trademark labels / Size labels / thread/Ironing/Packing in Box and bulk packing in Carton box etc. and valid for a period of 2 years.
- (2) KHDC will supply fabric based on the approved consumption.
- (3) Stitched shirts should be delivered to our finished goods Warehouse.
- (4) The Tenderers should be willing to undertake stitching work at a short notice and supply the finished shirts within the agreed delivery date.
- (5) Statutory deductions towards PF, ESI and TDS will be deducted at Source, while releasing payment of stitching charges.

- (6) Delayed delivery of stitched shirts will attract penalty which will be intimated at the time of release of the work orders.
- (7) Payment will be made within 30 days after inspection and acceptance of the stitched shirts/ pants by the Quality Control department of the Corporation. Rejection during inspection will be returned to the stitching unit and cost of material will be recovered.
- (8) Any rejection from the buyer at the later date will be debited to the tenderer, if any stitching/embellishment defects are noticed.
- (9) Stitching rates should be valid for a period of Two year from the date of finalisation of tender.
- (10) Corporation reserves the right to call the tenderers for negotiation of rates.
- (11) Corporation does not give any assurance about the volume of the order.
- (12) The Corporation reserves the Right to entrust/distribution stitching work to tenderers based on the requirement of KHDC from time to time.
- (13) Termination:
- (a) On completion of specific period of contract or
- (b) by giving 3 months' notice by either party.
